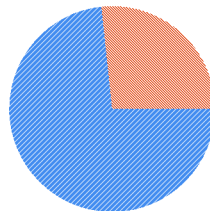

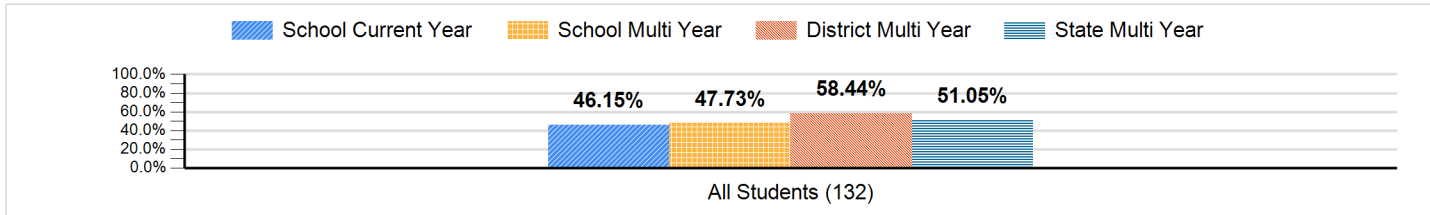
Student Population

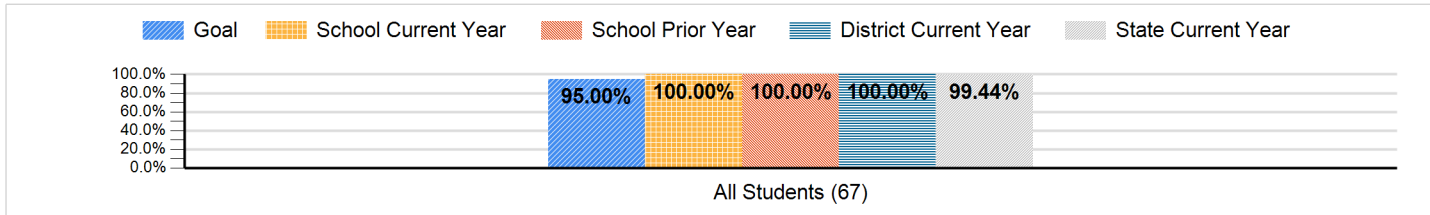

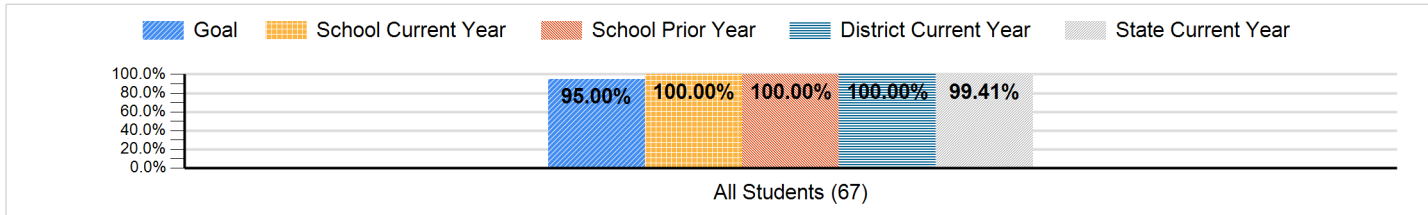

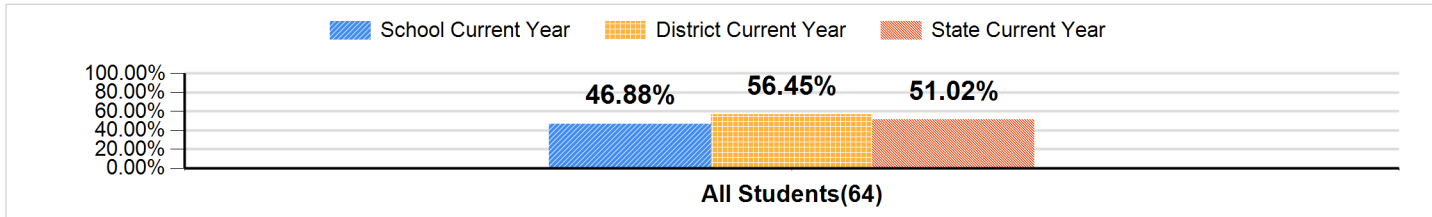

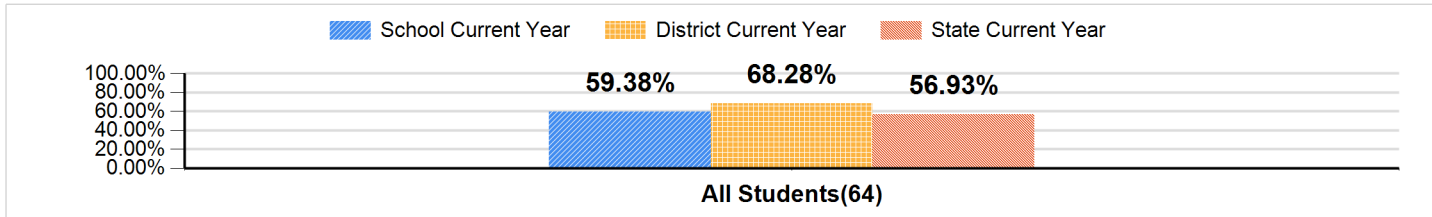

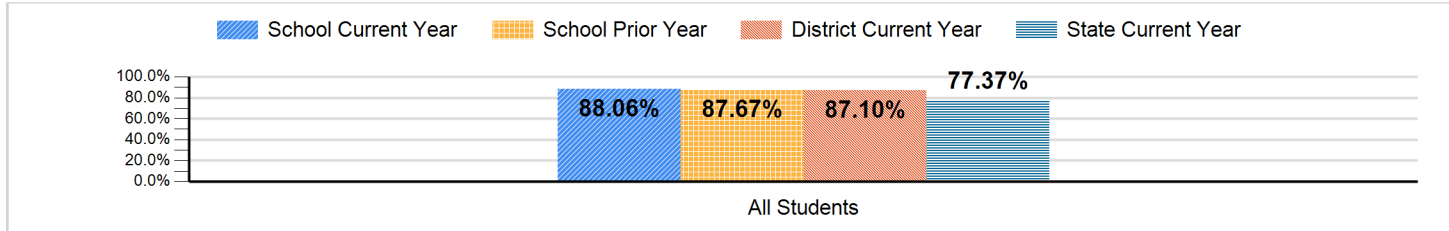
